AN ACT

1 Providing for the payment of tuition at certain institutions of
2 higher education for children of firemen and law enforcement
3 officers who are killed in line of duty.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. The Commonwealth of Pennsylvania shall provide
7 two years of full tuition at any State-owned or State-related
8 institution of higher education or community college for
9 children of firemen, whether a member of a municipal fire
10 department or of a volunteer fire company, and law enforcement
11 officers of the Commonwealth or any political subdivision
12 thereof who are killed in the performance of their duties.

13 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
