A RESOLUTION

1 Urging the Department of Transportation to produce and
2 distribute additional official transportation maps.

3 Each year the Department of Transportation prints and
4 distributes thousands of official transportation maps yet there
5 do not seem to be enough to adequately supply the demand; and

6 The Commonwealth spends millions of dollars each year to
7 promote tourism in Pennsylvania; and

8 Certainly the production and distribution of additional maps
9 will encourage tourists who travel through the Commonwealth on
10 the interstates to take more scenic routes and therefore spend
11 more time and money in Pennsylvania; and

12 It should also be pointed out that if the traveling public
13 had our maps available they could plan destinations in
14 Pennsylvania that they might otherwise bypass; therefore be it

15 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives urge the
16 Department of Transportation to print and distribute additional
17 official maps of Pennsylvania so that there is an adequate

1 supply; and be it further

2 RESOLVED, That a copy of this resolution be forwarded to the

3 Secretary of Transportation.
