A RESOLUTION

1 Congratulating the City of Hermitage.

2 In 1796, the township of Hickory was first settled in Mercer
3 County. In 1832 it became incorporated as a township and in 1954
4 it became a first class township. In 1975 the electors changed
5 the name of the township to Hermitage and this past November,
6 the township elected to become the City of Hermitage which was
7 accomplished by court order on January 1, 1984.

8 Located 80 miles northwest of Pittsburgh, Hermitage has a
9 population of 18,000 and a land area of 30 square miles.

10 Hermitage has the third largest municipal land area in the
11 Commonwealth. It is the commercial center of Mercer County with
12 600 business, professional and manufacturing firms.

13 Hermitage is now the newest city in Pennsylvania and
14 congratulations are in order; therefore be it

15 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the
16 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania extend its heartiest
17 congratulations to the City of Hermitage upon its becoming

1 Pennsylvania's newest city; and be it further
