A RESOLUTION

- 1 To designate the week of April 23 through 27, 1984 as "National Student Leadership Week."
- 3 WHEREAS, More than 10,000,000 young Americans, including
- 4 Pennsylvanians, are participating in cocurricular activities in
- 5 secondary schools across the Nation; and
- 6 WHEREAS, These activities, which include student government,
- 7 speech, debate, music, journalism, science, and mathematics
- 8 clubs, academic, vocational, and other student organizations,
- 9 contribute greatly to developing leadership qualities in our
- 10 youth; and
- 11 WHEREAS, These students will be our Commonwealth's and
- 12 Nation's future leaders; and
- 13 WHEREAS, It is in the national interest and the
- 14 Commonwealth's interest to promote increased emphasis in our
- 15 students' well-rounded education, which includes a rigorous
- 16 academic experience and successful leadership experiences in the
- 17 school setting; therefore be it

- 1 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the
- 2 week of April 23 through 27, 1984 as "National Student
- 3 Leadership Week" and that the Governor be requested to issue a
- 4 proclamation calling upon the citizens of this Commonwealth and
- 5 local government officials and interested groups to observe that
- 6 week by engaging in appropriate ceremonies, activities and
- 7 programs, thereby demonstrating their support for our students'
- 8 overall education.
