- 17 Section 2. Total authorization for bridge projects.
- 18 The total authorization for the costs of the projects
- itemized pursuant to section 3 and to be financed from current 19
- 20 revenue or by the incurring of debt shall be [\$979,196,000]
- \$979,921,000. 21

- 1 (b) The authorization for capital projects in the category
- 2 of Highway Projects to be constructed by the Department of
- 3 Transportation, its successors or assigns, and to be financed by
- 4 the incurring of debt or from the Highway-Railroad and Highway
- 5 Bridge Improvement Restricted Account within the Motor License
- 6 Fund, itemized in section 3 under the category of State bridges
- 7 is [\$747,800,000] <u>\$748,525,000</u>.
- 8 (c) The authorization for non-State highway bridge projects
- 9 to be constructed by local government municipalities and to be
- 10 financed in part with grants not exceeding 80% of the non-

- 13 deposited in the Highway Bridge Improvement Restricted Account
- 14 within the Motor License Fund, itemized in section 3 under the

- 20 Section 7. Debt authorization.
- 21 The Governor, Auditor General and State Treasurer are hereby
- 22 authorized and directed to borrow, from time to time, in
- 23 addition to any authorization heretofore or hereafter enacted,
- 24 on the credit of the Commonwealth, subject to the limitations
- 25 provided in the current capital budget, money not exceeding in
- 26 the aggregate the sum of [\$747,800,000] \$748,525,000 as may be
- 27 found necessary to carry out the acquisition and construction of
- 28 the highway projects, specifically itemized in section 3 of this
- 29 capital budget.
- 30 Section 10. Appropriation.

- 1 The net proceeds of the sale of the obligations herein
- 2 authorized are hereby appropriated from the Capital Facilities
- 3 Fund to the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation in the
- 4 maximum amount of [\$747,800,000] <u>\$748,525,000</u> to be used by it
- 5 exclusively to defray the financial costs of the projects
- 6 specifically itemized in section 3 of this capital budget. After
- 7 reserving or paying the expenses of the sale of the obligation,
- 8 the State Treasurer shall pay out to the Pennsylvania Department
- 9 of Transportation the moneys as required and certified by it to
- 10 be legally due and payable.
- 11 Section 4. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
