## AN ACT

Amending the act of July 22, 1974 (P.L.589, No.205), entitled 2 "An act relating to unfair insurance practices; prohibiting 3 unfair methods of competition and unfair or deceptive acts and practices; and prescribing remedies and penalties, " providing for disclosure of benefit limits when advertising quaranteed permanent life insurance to persons 50 years of 7 age or older. The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. Section 5(a) of the act of July 22, 1974 10 11 (P.L.589, No.205), known as the Unfair Insurance Practices Act, 12 is amended by adding a clause to read: 13 Section 5. Unfair Methods of Competition and Unfair or Deceptive Acts or Practices Defined .-- (a) "Unfair methods of 14 15 competition" and "unfair or deceptive acts or practices" in the business of insurance means: 16 17 18 (13) Making, issuing, publishing or circulating in any manner an advertisement, announcement or statement guaranteeing 19

permanent life insurance to persons fifty years of age or older

- 1 without equal accompanying disclosures, disclaimers or notices
- 2 <u>of limitations of liability or benefits.</u>

- 4 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
