AN ACT

- Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An 2 act relating to the public school system, including certain 3 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the 5 laws relating thereto, " providing for general, municipal and 6 primary election days to be legal holidays. The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:
- 9 Section 1. Section 1502 of the act of March 10, 1949
- 10 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949,
- amended January 24, 1966 (1965 P.L.1508, No.529), is amended to 11
- 12 read:
- 13 Section 1502. Days Schools not to be Kept Open. -- No school
- 14 shall be kept open on any Saturday for the purpose of ordinary
- 15 instruction, except when Monday is fixed by the board of school
- 16 directors as the weekly holiday, or on Sunday, Memorial Day,
- 17 Fourth of July, [or] Christmas or on any general, municipal or
- primary election day, nor shall any school be kept open in any 18
- district during the time of holding the teachers' institute for 19

- 1 such district. Whenever Memorial day shall be on a Sunday, the
- 2 following Monday shall be a holiday.
- Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately. 3
