AN ACT

1 Amending the act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1333, No.320), entitled
2 "An act concerning elections, including general, municipal,
3 special and primary elections, the nomination of candidates,
4 primary and election expenses and election contests; creating
5 and defining membership of county boards of elections;
6 imposing duties upon the Secretary of the Commonwealth,
7 courts, county boards of elections, county commissioners;
8 imposing penalties for violation of the act, and codifying,
9 revising and consolidating the laws relating thereto; and
10 repealing certain acts and parts of acts relating to
11 elections," eliminating certain seal requirements on certain
12 nomination petitions.

13 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
14 hereby enacts as follows:

15 Section 1. Section 809.1(c) of the act of June 3, 1937
16 (P.L.1333, No.320), known as the Pennsylvania Election Code,
17 added December 22, 1971 (P.L.613, No.165), is amended to read:

18 Section 809.1. Delegate and Alternate Delegate Commitments;
19 Authorization Required; Petitions.--* * *

20 (c) Nomination petitions for delegates committed to
21 particular presidential candidates shall [bear the imprint of
22 the seal of the Secretary of the Commonwealth and may] be

1 obtained only from the presidential candidate or his duly
2 authorized representative who is certified by the Secretary of
3 the Commonwealth as being authorized by the candidate to
4 distribute nomination petitions bearing his name.

5 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
