AN ACT

Amending the act of October 15, 1980 (P.L.950, No.164), entitled 2 "A supplement to the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), entitled 'An act providing for and reorganizing the conduct 3 4 of the executive and administrative work of the Commonwealth 5 by the Executive Department thereof and the administrative departments, boards, commissions, and officers thereof, 7 including the boards of trustees of State Normal Schools, or 8 Teachers Colleges; abolishing, creating, reorganizing or 9 authorizing the reorganization of certain administrative 10 departments, boards, and commissions; defining the powers and duties of the Governor and other executive and administrative 11 officers, and of the several administrative departments, 12 13 boards, commissions, and officers; fixing the salaries of the 14 Governor, Lieutenant Governor, and certain other executive and administrative officers; providing for the appointment of 15 16 certain administrative officers, and of all deputies and 17 other assistants and employes in certain departments, boards, and commissions; and prescribing the manner in which the number and compensation of the deputies and all other 18 19 20 assistants and employes of certain departments, boards and 21 commissions shall be determined, 'implementing the addition of section 4.1 to Article IV of the Constitution of 22 23 Pennsylvania; establishing the Office of Attorney General 24 elected by the citizens and setting forth powers and duties 25 of the Attorney General; creating an Office of General 26 Counsel and providing for legal services for Commonwealth 27 agencies; transferring, reorganizing or reconstituting 28 certain boards, commissions and agencies; placing certain 29 duties upon the courts and district attorneys; repealing 30 certain acts and parts of acts and making appropriations," providing for the review and approval of all contracts for 31 32 legal services initiated by the executive branch or an executive agency and for filings and reports relating to such 33

- 1 contracts for legal services.
- 2 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 3 hereby enacts as follows:
- 4 Section 1. The act of October 15, 1980 (P.L.950, No.164),
- 5 known as the Commonwealth Attorneys Act, is amended by adding a
- 6 section to read:
- 7 <u>Section 104. Contracts for Legal Services.</u>
- 8 (a) Approval. -- Prior to the execution of any contract by the
- 9 <u>executive branch or any executive agency for legal services to</u>
- 10 be provided by any professional corporation, partnership, law
- 11 <u>firm or private attorney who is not a Commonwealth employee, the</u>
- 12 contract shall be reviewed and approved by the Governor, the
- 13 Attorney General and the State Treasurer.
- 14 (b) Approval of modifications. -- Any addendum, amendment,
- 15 supplemental agreement or any other form of modification of a
- 16 contract for legal services which affects the nature or extent
- 17 of the legal services, the duration of the contract, the
- 18 financial terms of the contract or the provider of the services
- 19 shall be subject to the same review and approval as set forth in
- 20 subsection (a).
- 21 (c) Restrictions. -- No legal services shall be initiated
- 22 until the contract receives the approval of all three officers.
- 23 No legal services shall be provided beyond the time period of
- 24 the original contract or exceed the contracted ceiling prior to
- 25 the approval of any modification.
- 26 (d) Filing of contracts.--
- 27 (1) All contracts for legal services and any
- 28 modifications thereto shall be in writing and filed with the
- 29 State Treasurer and shall be subject to the provisions of the
- 30 act of June 21, 1957 (P.L.390, No.212), referred to as the

- 1 Right-to-Know Law.
- 2 (2) Copies of all contracts for legal services and any
- 3 <u>modifications thereto shall also be filed, upon execution,</u>
- 4 with the Majority and Minority Chairmen of the Appropriations
- 5 <u>Committees in the Senate and the House of Representatives</u>
- 6 along with a description of the purpose of the contract and a
- 7 <u>brief justification for the contract.</u>
- 8 (3) On or before December 31 of each year, the Governor,
- 9 <u>the Attorney General and the State Treasurer shall file</u>
- jointly with the President pro tempore of the Senate and the
- 11 Speaker of the House of Representatives an itemized listing
- of all contracted providers of legal services, the duration
- of the contract, the terms including any modifications and
- the financial costs for the calendar year covered by the
- 15 <u>filing.</u>
- 16 Section 2. The provisions of section 1 of this act shall
- 17 apply to all contracts executed on or after the effective date
- 18 of this act and to all modifications of any existing contracts
- 19 which modifications are executed on or after the effective date
- 20 of this act.
- 21 Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
