AN ACT

Amending the act of December 3, 1959 (P.L.1688, No.621), 2 entitled, as amended, "An act to promote the health, safety and welfare of the people of the Commonwealth by broadening 3 the market for housing for persons and families of low and 4 5 moderate income and alleviating shortages thereof, and by assisting in the provision of housing for elderly persons 7 through the creation of the Pennsylvania Housing Finance 8 Agency as a public corporation and government 9 instrumentality; providing for the organization, membership and administration of the agency, prescribing its general powers and duties and the manner in which its funds are kept 10 11 and audited, empowering the agency to make housing loans to 12 13 qualified mortgagors upon the security of insured and 14 uninsured mortgages, defining qualified mortgagors and 15 providing for priorities among tenants in certain instances, 16 prescribing interest rates and other terms of housing loans, 17 permitting the agency to acquire real or personal property, 18 permitting the agency to make agreements with financial 19 institutions and Federal agencies, providing for the purchase 20 by persons of low and moderate income of housing units, and 21 approving the sale of housing units, permitting the agency to sell housing loans, providing for the promulgation of 22 23 regulations and forms by the agency, prescribing penalties 24 for furnishing false information, empowering the agency to borrow money upon its own credit by the issuance and sale of 25 bonds and notes and by giving security therefor, permitting 26 the refunding, redemption and purchase of such obligations by 27 28 the agency, prescribing remedies of holders of such bonds and 29 notes, exempting bonds and notes of the agency, the income 30 therefrom, and the income and revenues of the agency from 31 taxation, except transfer, death and gift taxes; making such 32 bonds and notes legal investments for certain purposes; and 33 indicating how the act shall become effective," allowing the

- 1 agency to make loans independently of participation in a
- 2 Federal Housing Assistance Program; and saving an act from
- 3 expiration.
- 4 The Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby
- 5 enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 401-A(1) of the act of December 3, 1959
- 7 (P.L.1688, No.621), known as the Housing Finance Agency Law,
- 8 amended April 7, 1976 (P.L.73, No.33), is amended to read:
- 9 Section 401-A. Rental Housing Program. -- To accomplish the
- 10 declared purpose of this act of providing rental housing to
- 11 persons and families of low and moderate income the agency is
- 12 hereby authorized to:
- 13 (1) Make [first mortgage] loans secured by real property or
- 14 a leasehold estate, including mortgages [insured by a Federal
- 15 agency] or such other security as the agency determines to be
- 16 <u>necessary</u>, to finance projects designed and planned to be
- 17 available for low and moderate income persons and families or
- 18 elderly persons and others. [The agency shall not make any
- 19 mortgage loan pursuant to the provisions of this Article IV,
- 20 unless such mortgage loan is made in conjunction with a Federal
- 21 Housing Assistance Program; provided, however, that any mortgage
- 22 loan for which the agency had issued a written commitment and/or
- 23 projects for which the agency had issued written feasibility
- 24 approval on or before January 1, 1976, shall be excluded from
- 25 the limitations of this sentence.]
- 26 Section 2. Section 6 of the act of December 31, 1981
- 27 (P.L.594, No.176), entitled "An act amending the act of December
- 28 3, 1959 (P.L.1688, No.621), entitled, as amended, 'An act to
- 29 promote the health, safety and welfare of the people of the
- 30 Commonwealth by broadening the market for housing for persons
- 31 and families of low and moderate income and alleviating

- 1 shortages thereof, and by assisting in the provision of housing
- 2 for elderly persons through the creation of the Pennsylvania
- 3 Housing Finance Agency as a public corporation and government
- 4 instrumentality; providing for the organization, membership and
- 5 administration of the agency, prescribing its general powers and
- 6 duties and the manner in which its funds are kept and audited,
- 7 empowering the agency to make housing loans to qualified
- 8 mortgagors upon the security of insured and uninsured mortgages,
- 9 defining qualified mortgagors and providing for priorities among
- 10 tenants in certain instances, prescribing interest rates and
- 11 other terms of housing loans, permitting the agency to acquire
- 12 real or personal property, permitting the agency to make
- 13 agreements with financial institutions and Federal agencies,
- 14 providing for the purchase by persons of low and moderate income
- 15 of housing units, and approving the sale of housing units,
- 16 permitting the agency to sell housing loans, providing for the
- 17 promulgation of regulations and forms by the agency, prescribing
- 18 penalties for furnishing false information, empowering the
- 19 agency to borrow money upon its own credit by the issuance and
- 20 sale of bonds and notes and by giving security therefor,
- 21 permitting the refunding, redemption and purchase of such
- 22 obligations by the agency, prescribing remedies of holders of
- 23 such bonds and notes, exempting bonds and notes of the agency,
- 24 the income therefrom, and the income and revenues of the agency
- 25 from taxation, except transfer, death and gift taxes; making
- 26 such bonds and notes legal investments for certain purposes; and
- 27 indicating how the act shall become effective, 'providing for
- 28 the issuance of tax-free mortgage revenue bonds to encourage
- 29 housing within the Commonwealth," is repealed to the extent that
- 30 it provides for the expiration of Act 176 of 1981 on May 31,

- 1 1984, unless it is sooner amended or reenacted.
- Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately. 2
