- 1 Memorializing the Governor to proclaim March 20, 1984 as
- 2 Pennsylvania Agriculture Day.
- 3 WHEREAS, Agriculture is Pennsylvania's number one industry
- 4 and its associated production, processing and marketing segments
- 5 combined provide jobs for one-fifth of the work force in the
- 6 Commonwealth; and
- 7 WHEREAS, The productivity of Pennsylvania agriculture is a
- 8 vital ingredient in our strength as a Commonwealth and in the
- 9 strength of the Nation and the World; and
- 10 WHEREAS, To maintain a healthy agriculture, it is necessary
- 11 that all Pennsylvanians understand how agriculture affects their
- 12 lives and well-being and be aware of their personal reliance on
- 13 an abundant food and fiber supply; therefore be it
- 14 RESOLVED (the House of Representatives concurring), That the
- 15 General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania memorialize
- 16 the Governor to proclaim March 20, 1984 as Pennsylvania
- 17 Agriculture Day and to call upon the people of this Commonwealth
