A FIRE DEPARTMENT VEHICLE, POLICE VEHICLE, AMBULANCE, BLOOD-DELIVERY VEHICLE, ARMED FORCES 8 9 EMERGENCY VEHICLE, ONE VEHICLE OPERATED BY A CORONER OR CHIEF 10 COUNTY MEDICAL EXAMINER AND ONE VEHICLE OPERATED BY A CHIEF 11 DEPUTY CORONER OR DEPUTY CHIEF COUNTY MEDICAL EXAMINER USED FOR 12 ANSWERING EMERGENCY CALLS, ONE PRIVATE VEHICLE OF A FIRE OR 13 POLICE CHIEF OR ASSISTANT CHIEF OR, WHEN A FIRE COMPANY HAS 14 THREE OR MORE FIRE VEHICLES, A SECOND ASSISTANT CHIEF, OR FIRE 15 POLICE CAPTAIN AND FIRE POLICE LIEUTENANT OR AMBULANCE CORPS 16 COMMANDER OR ASSISTANT COMMANDER OR OF A RIVER RESCUE COMMANDER 17 OR ASSISTANT COMMANDER OR EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT COORDINATOR OR 18 FIRE MARSHAL USED FOR ANSWERING EMERGENCY CALLS OR OTHER VEHICLE 19 DESIGNATED BY THE STATE POLICE UNDER SECTION 6106 (RELATING TO 20 DESIGNATION OF EMERGENCY VEHICLES BY PENNSYLVANIA STATE POLICE). * * * 21

6 (C) MECHANICAL, ELECTRICAL AND ELECTRONIC DEVICES
7 AUTHORIZED.--

8 (1) [THE] <u>EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION,</u> 9 <u>THE</u> RATE OF SPEED OF ANY VEHICLE MAY BE TIMED ON ANY HIGHWAY 10 BY A POLICE OFFICER USING A MECHANICAL OR ELECTRICAL SPEED 11 TIMING DEVICE.

12 (2) ELECTRONIC DEVICES SUCH AS RADIO-MICROWAVE DEVICES
13 (COMMONLY REFERRED TO AS ELECTRONIC SPEED METERS OR RADAR)
14 MAY BE USED ONLY BY MEMBERS OF THE PENNSYLVANIA STATE POLICE.
15 NO PERSON MAY BE CONVICTED UPON EVIDENCE OBTAINED THROUGH THE
16 USE OF SUCH DEVICES UNLESS THE SPEED RECORDED IS SIX OR MORE
17 MILES PER HOUR IN EXCESS OF THE LEGAL SPEED LIMIT.

(e) Distance requirements for use of mechanical, electrical 19 20 and electronic devices. -- Mechanical, electrical or electronic devices may not be used to time the rate of speed of vehicles 21 22 within 1,000 feet of AFTER a speed limit sign indicating a 23 decrease of speed. This limitation on the use of speed timing 24 devices shall not apply to speed limit signs indicating school 25 zones, BRIDGE AND ELEVATED STRUCTURE SPEED LIMITS, HAZARDOUS 26 GRADE SPEED LIMITS AND WORK ZONE SPEED LIMITS. 27 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days. 28 SECTION 4. SECTION 4706(D) OF TITLE 75 IS AMENDED TO READ:

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PROGRAM.

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(D) CHARGE FOR INSPECTION.--WHENEVER A SYSTEM FOR THE
PERIODIC INSPECTION OF EMISSIONS OR EMISSION SYSTEMS IS
ESTABLISHED AS AUTHORIZED IN SUBSECTION (B), THE MAXIMUM CHARGE
FOR SUCH INSPECTION SHALL BE [\$5] <u>\$8</u>. NO ADDITIONAL CHARGE SHALL
BE MADE BY THE INSPECTING STATION FOR ONE NECESSARY REINSPECTION
WITHIN 30 DAYS OF THE ORIGINAL INSPECTION.

13 (G) COMBINATIONS PERMITTED UNDER SECTION 4965(2).--14 COMBINATIONS PERMITTED ONLY TO CROSS A HIGHWAY TO GET FROM ONE 15 COMMERCIAL OR INDUSTRIAL FACILITY TO ANOTHER UNDER SECTION 16 4965(2) (RELATING TO SINGLE PERMITS FOR MULTIPLE HIGHWAY 17 CROSSINGS) MAY CONSIST OF MORE THAN TWO UNITS AS LONG AS THE 18 DIMENSIONS AND GROSS AXLE AND WHEEL WEIGHT OF THE COMBINATION 19 AND LOADS DO NOT EXCEED THE MAXIMUMS SPECIFIED IN THIS CHAPTER. 20 SECTION 6. UPON APPLICATION IN WRITING SHOWING GOOD CAUSE, ISSUE SPECIAL
PERMITS IN WRITING AUTHORIZING THE APPLICANT TO OPERATE OR MOVE
ON SPECIFIED HIGHWAYS ANY OF THE FOLLOWING:

A SINGLE PERMIT MAY BE ISSUED FOR A NUMBER OF MOVEMENTS 21 ACROSS THE HIGHWAY AT SPECIFIED LOCATIONS WITHIN A FIXED PERIOD 22 23 OF TIME OF VEHICLES OR COMBINATIONS: 24 (1) EXCEEDING THE MAXIMUM SIZE OR WEIGHT SPECIFIED IN 25 THIS CHAPTER; OR 26 (2) USED TO CROSS A HIGHWAY TO GET FROM ONE COMMERCIAL 27 OR INDUSTRIAL FACILITY TO ANOTHER COMMERCIAL OR INDUSTRIAL 28 FACILITY UNDER THE SAME OPERATION. 29 WHENEVER A PERMIT IS ISSUED FOR CROSSING THE HIGHWAY, IT IS

1 SECTION 9. (A) SECTION 4 (RELATING TO SECTION 4706(D)) OF 2 THE ACT SHALL TAKE EFFECT SEPTEMBER 1, 1985, OR IMMEDIATELY, 3 WHICHEVER IS LATER.

4 (B) SECTIONS 2, 5, 6, 7 AND 8 OF THIS ACT SHALL TAKE EFFECT 5 IN 90 DAYS.

6 (C) SECTIONS 1 AND 3 OF THIS ACT SHALL TAKE EFFECT IN 60 7 DAYS.

8 (D) SECTION 9 OF THIS ACT SHALL TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.
