## AN ACT

- 1 Imposing a moratorium on the construction and operation of
- 2 private prisons; and charging the Department of Corrections
- with the responsibility to conduct an investigation of
- 4 private prisons.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Moratorium on construction and operation of private
- 8 prisons.
- 9 (a) Prohibition.--On and after the effective date of this
- 10 act, no private prison shall be constructed or operated within
- 11 this Commonwealth.
- 12 (b) End of moratorium. -- The prohibition against the
- 13 construction and operation of private prisons shall remain in
- 14 effect until the investigation required by section 2 has been
- 15 completed.
- 16 (c) Definition.--As used in this section the term "private
- 17 prison" means any facility for prisoners that is not owned or
- 18 operated by the United States, the Commonwealth, a county or

- 1 other municipality.
- 2 Section 2. Investigation by Department of Corrections.
- 3 (a) Use of private prisons. -- The Department of Corrections
- 4 shall conduct a full-scale investigation of the implications and
- 5 ramifications of the use of private prisons in this
- 6 Commonwealth.
- 7 (b) Time for investigation.--The Department of Corrections
- 8 shall commence its investigation within 30 days of the effective
- 9 date of this act and shall issue a report of its findings to the
- 10 General Assembly not later than one year after the effective
- 11 date of this act.
- 12 Section 3. Effective date.
- 13 This act shall take effect immediately.
