- 1 Amending Title 66 (Public Utilities) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, providing for certain exceptions to
- 3 the payment of damages.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 2704(a) of Title 66 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 8 § 2704. Compensation for damages occasioned by construction,
- 9 relocation or abolition of crossings.
- 10 (a) General rule. -- The compensation for damages which the
- 11 owners of adjacent property taken, injured, or destroyed may
- 12 sustain in the construction, relocation, alteration, protection,
- 13 or abolition of any crossing under the provisions of this part,
- 14 shall, after due notice and hearing, be ascertained and
- 15 determined by the commission. Such compensation, as well as the
- 16 cost of construction, relocation, alteration, protection, or
- 17 abolition of such crossing, and of facilities at or adjacent to
- 18 such crossing which are used in any kind of public utility

- 1 service, shall be borne and paid, as provided in this section,
- 2 by the public utilities or municipal corporations concerned, or
- 3 by the Commonwealth, in such proper proportions as the
- 4 commission may, after due notice and hearing, determine, unless
- 5 such proportions are mutually agreed upon and paid by the
- 6 interested parties. For the purposes of this section, a county
- 7 <u>shall not be deemed to be an interested party.</u>

- 9 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
