AN ACT

1 Making appropriations to The Medical College of Pennsylvania,  
2 East Falls, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania.

3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
4 hereby enacts as follows:

5 Section 1. The sum of \$2,489,000 is hereby appropriated to  
6 The Medical College of Pennsylvania located in East Falls,  
7 Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, for the fiscal year July 1, 1985, to  
8 June 30, 1986, for instruction in the Doctor of Medicine program  
9 and for participation by a representative of the institution,  
10 appointed by the chief executive officer thereof, as a member of  
11 the Pennsylvania Academic Commission on Technological  
12 Development, a commission for interinstitutional communication  
13 regarding technological innovation and development and for  
14 dissemination of information on such matters to the Pennsylvania  
15 business community and others who may use such information for  
16 new business and job development in Pennsylvania, such  
17 commission to be composed of representatives of every State-

1 owned or State-related educational or scientific institution  
2 receiving General Fund assistance from the Commonwealth.

3 Section 2. The sum of ~~\$279,000~~ \$529,000 is hereby <—  
4 appropriated to The Medical College of Pennsylvania,  
5 Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, for the fiscal year July 1, 1985, to  
6 June 30, 1986, for the general maintenance of The Medical  
7 College of Pennsylvania, including the School of Allied Health,  
8 and student aid.

9 Section 3. Payments to The Medical College of Pennsylvania  
10 on account of the appropriations provided in sections 1 and 2  
11 shall be made quarterly by the Secretary of Education on the  
12 basis of costs during the fiscal year.

13 Section 4. The Medical College of Pennsylvania shall provide  
14 such information and in such form and manner as the Department  
15 of Education may prescribe.

16 Section 5. The Medical College of Pennsylvania shall report  
17 its revenues and expenditures and present its financial  
18 statements in accordance with generally accepted accounting  
19 principles and procedures for educational institutions as set  
20 forth in the "Higher Education Finance Manual of 1975," without  
21 exception.

22 Section 6. This act shall take effect July 1, 1985, or  
23 immediately, whichever is later.
