AN ACT

- 1 Repealing certain acts relating to gypsies.
- 2 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 3 hereby enacts as follows:
- 4 Section 1. Repeals.
- 5 The following acts are repealed:
- 6 The act of May 6, 1909 (P.L.445, No.247), entitled "An act to
- 7 require roving bands of nomads, commonly called gypsies, and the
- 8 persons composing such bands, who have no permanent place of
- 9 abode in this Commonwealth, to take out a license to pitch or
- 10 settle their encampments, or carry on their transactions or
- 11 practice their craft, within the limits of any county of this
- 12 State, fixing the amount of such license, and prescribing the
- 13 penalty for violation of the same.
- 14 The act of April 7, 1927 (P.L.144, No.114), entitled "An act
- 15 authorizing boards of health to require roving bands, or bands
- 16 of nomads, commonly called gypsies, declared to be nuisances or

- 1 menaces to health, to leave municipalities, and providing
- 2 penalties.
- 3 Section 2. Effective date.
- 4 This act shall take effect immediately.
