AN ACT

1 Amending the act of May 1, 1933 (P.L.103, No.69), entitled "An  
2 act concerning townships of the second class; and amending,  
3 revising, consolidating, and changing the law relating  
4 thereto," further providing for the compensation of  
5 supervisors.

6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
7 hereby enacts as follows:

8 Section 1. Section 515 of the act of May 1, 1933 (P.L.103,  
9 No.69), known as The Second Class Township Code, reenacted and  
10 amended July 10, 1947 (P.L.1481, No.567) and amended November 2,  
11 1973 (P.L.324, No.105), is amended to read:

12 Section 515. Compensation of Supervisors.--Supervisors may  
13 receive from the general township fund, as compensation,  
14 [twenty-five dollars for each meeting which they attend.] an  
15 amount fixed by ordinance not in excess of the following:

<u>Township Population</u>	<u>Annual Maximum Compensation</u>
<u>Not more than 2,499</u>	<u>One thousand dollars</u>
<u>2,500 to 4,999</u>	<u>Fifteen hundred dollars</u>

1	<u>5,000 to 9,999</u>	<u>Two thousand dollars</u>
2	<u>10,000 to 14,999</u>	<u>Twenty-six hundred dollars</u>
3	<u>15,000 to 24,999</u>	<u>Thirty-three hundred dollars</u>
4	<u>25,000 to 34,999</u>	<u>Thirty-five hundred dollars</u>
5	<u>35,000 or more</u>	<u>Four thousand dollars</u>

6 Such salaries shall be payable monthly or quarterly for the  
7 duties imposed by the provisions of this act. The population  
8 shall be determined by the latest available official census  
9 figures. The compensation of supervisors, when acting as  
10 superintendents, roadmasters or laborers, shall be fixed by the  
11 township auditors either per hour, per day, per week, semi-  
12 monthly or monthly, which compensation shall not exceed  
13 compensation paid in the locality for similar services, and such  
14 other reasonable compensation for the use of a passenger car, or  
15 a two-axled four-wheeled motor truck having a chassis weight of  
16 less than two thousand pounds and a maximum gross weight of five  
17 thousand pounds, or a class 2 truck, having a maximum gross  
18 weight of seven thousand pounds when required and actually used  
19 for the transportation of road and bridge laborers and their  
20 hand tools and for the distribution of cinders and patching  
21 material from a stock pile, as the auditors shall determine and  
22 approve; but no supervisor shall receive compensation as a  
23 superintendent or roadmaster for any [day he receives  
24 compensation for] time he spends attending a meeting of  
25 supervisors[, unless such meeting is held after regular working  
26 hours].

27 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
