## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, making it unlawful to knowingly
- 3 transmit acquired immune deficiency syndrome through sexual
- 4 contact.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 8 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 9 § 5905. Transmitting acquired immune deficiency syndrome.
- 10 (a) Offense defined. -- A person who, knowing that he is
- 11 infected by acquired immune deficiency syndrome, transmits the
- 12 disease to another person through sexual contact, commits a
- 13 misdemeanor of the first degree.
- 14 (b) Second or subsequent offense.--A person convicted of a
- 15 second or subsequent offense under this section commits a felony
- 16 of the second degree.
- 17 (c) Definitions. -- As used in this section the following
- 18 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this

- 1 <u>subsection:</u>
- 2 "Intimate parts." The following body parts: sexual organs,
- 3 genital area, anal area, inner thigh, groin, buttock or breast
- 4 of a person.
- 5 "Sexual contact." An intentional touching by the victim or
- 6 offender, either directly or through clothing, of the victim's
- 7 <u>or offender's intimate parts.</u>
- 8 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
