- (h) [Exceptions and appeal] Appeal procedure. -- Any party to 10
- 11 a proceeding referred to an administrative law judge under
- section 331(b) may [file exceptions to the decision of the 12
- administrative law judge within 15 days after such decision is 13
- 14 issued, in a form and manner to be prescribed by the commission.
- The administrative law judge shall rule upon such exceptions 15
- within 30 days after filing. Any party to the proceeding may] 16
- appeal to the commission from the [ruling] decision of the 17

- 1 administrative law judge [on the exceptions] within [15] 21 days
- 2 after such [ruling] decision is issued. [If no exceptions are
