AN ACT

- Amending the act of November 4, 1983 (P.L.217, No.63), entitled
 "An act establishing a program of limited pharmaceutical
 assistance for the elderly; granting powers to and imposing
 duties on the Department of Aging; establishing a payment
 system; making provisions for funding; providing for reports;
 and fixing penalties for violations of the pharmaceutical
 assistance program," further providing for eligibility.
- 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 9 hereby enacts as follows:
- 10 Section 1. Section 4(a) of the act of November 4, 1983
- 11 (P.L.217, No.63), known as the Pharmaceutical Assistance
- 12 Contract for the Elderly Act, is amended to read:
- 13 Section 4. Responsibilities of Department of Aging.
- 14 (a) Determination of eligibility. -- The department shall
- 15 adopt regulations relating to the determination of eligibility
- 16 of prospective claimants and providers including dispensing
- 17 physicians and the determination and elimination of program
- 18 abuse. The department shall have the power to declare ineligible

- 1 any claimant who abuses or misuses the established prescription
- 2 plan. The department shall have the power to investigate cases
- 3 of suspected provider or recipient fraud. In the case of a
- 4 spouse widowed within one year of the date of the application,
- 5 <u>financial eliqibility shall be based on the most recently filed</u>
- 6 State or Federal income tax form or proof of income for six
- 7 months prior to the date of application, whichever benefits the
- 8 applicant.

- 10 Section 2. This act shall apply to applications filed on or
- 11 after the effective date hereof.
- 12 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
