7	Section 1. Section 4902(g) of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
8	Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
9	§ 4902. Restrictions on use of highways and bridges.

11	(g) Penalty
12	(1) Any person operating a vehicle or combination upon a
13	highway or bridge in violation of a prohibition or
14	restriction imposed under subsection (a) is guilty of a
15	summary offense and shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to
16	pay a fine of \$75, except that any person convicted of
17	operating a vehicle with a gross weight in excess of a posted
18	weight shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of

\$150 plus \$150 for each 500 pounds, or part thereof, in
 excess of 3,000 pounds over the maximum allowable weight.

(2) Any person operating a vehicle or combination in
violation of a prohibition or restriction imposed under
subsection (b) is guilty of a summary offense and shall, upon
conviction, be sentenced to pay <u>for a first offense</u> a fine of
not less than [\$25 and not more than] \$100 <u>nor more than</u>
<u>\$300</u>, and for a second or subsequent offense a fine of \$300.
Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
