AN ACT

1 Amending the act of June 23, 1931 (P.L.932, No.317), entitled
2 "An act relating to cities of the third class; and amending,
3 revising, and consolidating the law relating thereto,"
4 further providing for the administration of public health.

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. Section 2301 of the act of June 23, 1931
8 (P.L.932, No.317), known as The Third Class City Code, reenacted
9 and amended June 28, 1951 (P.L.662, No.164), is amended to read:

10 Section 2301. Board of Health; Incompatibility.--Each city
11 [shall] may, by ordinance, create a board of health as herein
12 provided, or, in lieu thereof, [council shall be] may, by
13 ordinance, designate itself as the board of health. If the
14 council does not create a board of health nor designate itself
15 as the board of health, section 2102(h) of the act of April 9,
16 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), known as "The Administrative Code of
17 1929," shall apply. If section 2102(h) of "The Administrative
18 Code of 1929" applies, the remainder of this article shall not

1 apply. The board of health shall have five members appointed by
2 council, who shall serve without compensation. Except as
3 otherwise herein provided, membership on the board of health
4 shall be incompatible with every other city office.

5 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
