## AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of June 23, 1931 (P.L.932, No.317), entitled
- 2 "An act relating to cities of the third class; and amending,
- 3 revising, and consolidating the law relating thereto,"
- 4 further providing for the administration of public health.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Section 2301 of the act of June 23, 1931
- 8 (P.L.932, No.317), known as The Third Class City Code, reenacted
- 9 and amended June 28, 1951 (P.L.662, No.164), is amended to read:
- 10 Section 2301. Board of Health; Incompatibility.--Each city
- 11 [shall] may, by ordinance, create a board of health as herein
- 12 provided, or, in lieu thereof, [council shall be] may, by
- 13 ordinance, designate itself as the board of health. If the
- 14 council does not create a board of health nor designate itself
- 15 as the board of health, section 2102(h) of the act of April 9,
- 16 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), known as "The Administrative Code of
- 17 1929, " shall apply. If section 2102(h) of "The Administrative
- 18 Code of 1929" applies, the remainder of this article shall not

- 1 apply. The board of health shall have five members appointed by
- 2 council, who shall serve without compensation. Except as
- 3 otherwise herein provided, membership on the board of health
- 4 shall be incompatible with every other city office.
- 5 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
