## AN ACT

Amending the act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1333, No.320), entitled "An act concerning elections, including general, municipal, 2 3 special and primary elections, the nomination of candidates, primary and election expenses and election contests; creating and defining membership of county boards of elections; 5 6 imposing duties upon the Secretary of the Commonwealth, 7 courts, county boards of elections, county commissioners; imposing penalties for violation of the act, and codifying, 8 revising and consolidating the laws relating thereto; and 9 repealing certain acts and parts of acts relating to 10 11 elections," changing the date for the general primary in the 12 year of the nomination of a President of the United States. 13 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 14 hereby enacts as follows: 15 Section 1. Section 603 of the act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1333, 16 No.320), known as the Pennsylvania Election Code, amended November 3, 1983 (P.L.208, No.59), is amended to read: 17 18 Section 603. General Primary; Candidates to Be Nominated and 19 Party Officers to Be Elected.--[(a)] There shall be a General 20 primary preceding each general election which shall be held on the third Tuesday of May in all even-numbered years, except in 21 22 the year of the nomination of a President of the United States,

- 1 in which year the General primary shall be held on the [fourth]
- 2 <u>first</u> Tuesday of April. Candidates for all offices to be filled
- 3 at the ensuing general election shall be nominated at the
- 4 General primary. The vote for candidates for the office of
- 5 President of the United States, as provided for by this act,
- 6 shall be cast at the General primary.
- 7 [(b) Notwithstanding subsection (a), the General primary for
- 8 1984 shall be held on April 10, 1984.]
- 9 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
