2 3 4 5 6	investigate a problem relating to the adequacy and availability of insurance for real and personal property against loss caused by radioactive contamination originating from an extraordinary nuclear occurrence at a power generating facility.
7	WHEREAS, The present method of treating the risk of
8	radioactive contamination caused by a nuclear occurrence at a
9	nuclear power generating facility does not provide for direct
10	insurance coverage to property other than nuclear power plants;
11	and
12	WHEREAS, The Federal Price Anderson Act limits the liability
13	of nuclear power plant operators and owners for damage to
14	property of persons off-site of a nuclear power plant; and
15	WHEREAS, All property insurance contracts providing insurance
16	against loss or damage to real and personal property exclude any
17	loss or damage to such property caused by nuclear power; and
18	WHEREAS, Nuclear power is an important energy resource to the
19	people of Pennsylvania in the sense that in excess of 16% of our

- 1 electrical energy is derived from nuclear power; and
- 2 WHEREAS, Nearly every property owner within this Commonwealth
- 3 has a potential exposure to or risk of loss to their property
- 4 from radioactive contamination in the event of a nuclear
- 5 occurrence that would release radioactive contaminant beyond the
- 6 confines of a nuclear plant site situated within this
- 7 Commonwealth or in a state adjacent to this Commonwealth; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Many property owners in this Commonwealth have
- 9 expressed concern about the unavailability of nuclear property
- 10 insurance coverage to protect their investment in such property
- 11 and have expressed an interest in purchasing nuclear property
- 12 insurance; therefore be it
- 13 RESOLVED, That the Speaker of the House of Representatives
- 14 appoint a nine member bipartisan committee, five from the
- 15 majority party and four from the minority party, to investigate
- 16 the problem of the unavailability of nuclear property insurance
- 17 to property owners in this Commonwealth; and be it further
- 18 RESOLVED, That the committee may hold hearings, take
- 19 testimony and make its investigation at such places as it deems
- 20 necessary within this Commonwealth; and be it further
- 21 RESOLVED, That the committee be specifically charged with
- 22 identifying any impediments in State or Federal law to the
- 23 providing of nuclear property insurance and to present a
- 24 recommendation or recommendations of legislative initiatives for
- 25 this Commonwealth or the United States Congress to assure the
- 26 availability of adequate nuclear property insurance to meet the
- 27 needs of the people of Pennsylvania; and be it further
- 28 RESOLVED, That the special committee receive necessary
- 29 staffing from current staff resources available to the majority
- 30 and minority caucuses; and be it further

- 1 RESOLVED, That the special committee report its findings and
- 2 recommendations to the House of Representatives at least 90 days
- 3 prior to the end of the session of the General Assembly.
