### A RESOLUTION

1 Memorializing the United States Congress and the United States  
2 Department of Commerce to examine the recent sale of a steel  
3 rod mill by the United States Steel Corporation to China.

4 WHEREAS, The United States Steel Corporation has sold its  
5 Fairless Works steel rod mill in Bucks County, Pennsylvania, to  
6 a Chinese manufacturer; and

7 WHEREAS, Countless numbers of laid-off steel workers are  
8 looking for work and have been unemployed for long periods of  
9 time; and

10 WHEREAS, The steel rod mill is only 16 years old and could  
11 employ many persons; therefore be it

12 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives memorialize the  
13 United States Congress and the United States Department of  
14 Commerce to closely examine this transaction to determine its  
15 impact on the steel industry in Pennsylvania as well as the  
16 United States; and be it further

17 RESOLVED, That copies of this resolution be transmitted to  
18 the President of the United States, to the Secretary of the

1 United States Department of Commerce, to the presiding officers  
2 of each house of Congress and to each member of Congress from  
3 Pennsylvania.
