A RESOLUTION

1 Memorializing the General Assembly of the United Nations to
2 support the Afghan people in their struggle against Soviet
3 aggression.

4 WHEREAS, Afghanistan is currently occupied by the armed
5 forces of the Soviet Union intent upon turning that country into
6 a Soviet satellite state; and

7 WHEREAS, The Afghan people, particularly the children, have
8 suffered and continue to suffer from the imposition of atheistic
9 communist despotism; therefore be it

10 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the
11 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania memorialize the General Assembly of
12 the United Nations to support the Afghan people in their
13 struggle against the Soviet occupation of their country; and be
14 it further

15 RESOLVED, That a copy of this resolution be transmitted to
16 the United States Ambassador to the United Nations, and to the
