A RESOLUTION

- 1 Directing the Transportation Committee to undertake a study of
- the driver's license examination units in this Commonwealth.
- 3 WHEREAS, The General Assembly finds that the efficient
- 4 operation of driver's license examination units is in large part
- 5 dependent upon the geographical location and personnel
- 6 complement of the unit; and
- 7 WHEREAS, The General Assembly expects the number of examiners
- 8 to be directly related to the number of anticipated driver
- 9 examinations to be given; and
- 10 WHEREAS, The General Assembly has found that the current
- 11 operation of the driver's license examination units does not
- 12 promote the level of efficiency which would be expected;
- 13 therefore be it
- 14 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives direct the
- 15 Transportation Committee to undertake an immediate study of the
- 16 courses of action which can be taken, either administratively or
- 17 by legislation, to promote the efficient location, staffing and

- 1 operation of the driver's license examination units; and be it
- 2 further
- 3 RESOLVED, That the committee may hold hearings, take
- 4 testimony and make its investigations at such places as it deems
- 5 necessary in this Commonwealth. Each member of the committee
- 6 shall have power to administer oaths and affirmations to
- 7 witnesses appearing before the committee; and be it further
- 8 RESOLVED, That the committee make a report of its findings
- 9 and recommendations to the House of Representatives within 90
- 10 days.
