## AN ACT

Amending the act of July 2, 1984 (P.L.527, No.106), entitled "An 2 act providing for the rehabilitation, development and 3 acquisition of land, water and structural resources; defining the powers and duties of certain offices, agencies and 5 municipalities; providing for the allotment of proceeds hereunder including Commonwealth grants; prescribing 7 standards; and making appropriations, "increasing an appropriation; and extending the time for the use of the 8 funds. 10 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 11 hereby enacts as follows: 12 Section 1. Sections 4(a)(1) and 9 of the act of July 2, 1984 13 (P.L.527, No.106), known as the Recreational Improvement and 14 Rehabilitation Act, are amended to read: 15 Section 4. Appropriation of moneys. 16 Appropriation. -- From the moneys received by the Commonwealth from the issuance and sale of bonds and notes 17

- 18 pursuant to the act of July 2, 1984, (P.L.512, No.104), known as
- 19 the Pennsylvania Economic Revitalization Act, there are hereby
- 20 appropriated as follows:
- 21 (1) The sum of [\$12,000,000] \$18,000,000, or as much

- 1 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the
- 2 Pennsylvania Economic Revitalization Fund to the Department
- of Environmental Resources for the period beginning July 1,
- 4 1984, and ending June 30, [1986] <u>1987</u>, for site development
- 5 and material costs for projects authorized and funded under
- 6 the act of July 2, 1984 (P.L.561, No.112), known as the
- 7 Pennsylvania Conservation Corps Act. The Secretary of
- 8 Environmental Resources shall have the power to promulgate
- 9 such statements of policy, guidelines, rules and regulations
- 10 as may be necessary to effectuate the programs undertaken,
- including contracting with persons, firms, partnerships,
- associations or corporations as may be necessary. The
- 13 Department of Environmental Resources shall establish
- 14 procedures for the application and distribution of funds
- pursuant to this section. Municipalities sponsoring projects
- authorized and funded under the Pennsylvania Conservation
- 17 Corps Act shall be eligible to receive funding under this
- 18 paragraph only for those projects having recreation purposes
- 19 and then no more than 75% of the cost of development and
- 20 materials for those projects. All other projects sponsored by
- 21 municipalities shall be ineligible for funding under this
- 22 paragraph.

- 24 Section 9. Termination.
- No funds under this act shall be encumbered by the Department
- 26 of Environmental Resources after June 30, [1986] 1987, or
- 27 awarded as grants-in-aid by the Department of Community Affairs
- 28 after June 30, 1987. [Funds not expended by the Department of
- 29 Environmental Resources by June 30, 1986, shall be
- 30 reappropriated by the General Assembly for eligible recreation

- 1 purposes under the provisions of this act.]
- 2 Section 2. The act is amended by adding a section to read: <--
- 3 <u>Section 9.1 Appropriation credit.</u>
- 4 <u>All funds expended or encumbered under the appropriation of</u>
- 5 section 202 of the act of July 1, 1985 (P.L. , No.10A), known
- 6 <u>as the Pennsylvania Economic Revitalization Fund, or this act</u>
- 7 shall be credited against the appropriations made herein.
- 8 Section 3 2. This act shall take effect immediately. <--
