AN ACT

- 1 Making an appropriation from the Professional Licensure
- 2 Augmentation Account and from restricted revenue accounts
- 3 within the General Fund to the Department of State for use by
- 4 the Bureau of Professional and Occupational Affairs.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. The sum of \$10,390,000, or as much thereof as may
- 8 be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the Professional
- 9 Licensure Augmentation Account and the restricted receipts
- 10 accounts of the State Board of Medicine, the State Board of
- 11 Osteopathic Medicine and the State Board of Podiatry within the
- 12 General Fund to the Department of State to augment the
- 13 Professional and Occupational Affairs appropriation for the
- 14 operation of the Bureau of Professional and Occupational Affairs
- 15 for the fiscal year July 1, 1986, to June 30, 1987.
- 16 Section 2. The appropriation in section 1 shall be composed
- 17 of the sum of \$8,833,000, to be drawn from the Professional
- 18 Licensure Augmentation Account, and the sum of \$1,557,000, to be

- 1 drawn from the restricted receipts accounts within the General
- 2 Fund for the State Board of Medicine, the State Board of
- 3 Osteopathic Medicine and the State Board of Podiatry.
- 4 Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 1986, or
- 5 immediately, whichever is later.
