AN ACT

- 1 Creating a commission to ensure the coordination of efforts to
- 2 observe the 125th Anniversary of the Battle of Gettysburg and
- 3 Lincoln's Gettysburg Address.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Commission created.
- 7 The General Assembly hereby creates the Battle of Gettysburg
- 8 125th Anniversary Commission to ensure the coordination of
- 9 efforts to observe the 125th Anniversary of the Battle of
- 10 Gettysburg and Lincoln's Gettysburg Address.
- 11 Section 2. Duties.
- 12 The duties of the commission will be:
- 13 (1) To facilitate cooperative efforts between State
- 14 agencies and those public and private organizations which are
- 15 planning activities commemorating this anniversary.
- 16 (2) To invite the cooperation of the Congress of the
- 17 United States and the legislatures of the other states.
- 18 (3) To authorize expenditures of Commonwealth funds

- 1 appropriated to support the activities of the 125th
- 2 Anniversary.
- 3 (4) To submit a report to the General Assembly of the
- 4 activities of the commission and make recommendations
- 5 concerning the commemoration of the 125th Anniversary.
- 6 Section 3. Members.
- 7 The commission shall be comprised of nine ELEVEN citizens of <--
- 8 this Commonwealth who, SEVEN OF WHOM shall be appointed by the <-

- 9 Governor, AND ONE OF WHOM SHALL BE APPOINTED BY EACH OF THE
- 10 FOLLOWING: THE PRESIDENT PRO TEMPORE OF THE SENATE, THE MINORITY
- 11 LEADER OF THE SENATE, THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF
- 12 REPRESENTATIVES AND THE MINORITY LEADER OF THE HOUSE OF
- 13 REPRESENTATIVES.
- 14 Section 4. Expiration.
- The commission shall complete its business and submit its
- 16 final report to the General Assembly by June 30, 1989. This act
- 17 and the commission shall expire June 30, 1989.
- 18 Section 5. Effective date.
- 19 This act shall take effect immediately.
