### AN ACT

1 Amending the act of August 26, 1971 (P.L.351, No.91), entitled  
2 "An act providing for a State Lottery and administration  
3 thereof; authorizing the creation of a State Lottery  
4 Commission; prescribing its powers and duties; disposition of  
5 funds; violations and penalties therefor; exemption of prizes  
6 from State and local taxation and making an appropriation,"  
7 prohibiting the awarding of certain prizes.

8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
9 hereby enacts as follows:

10 Section 1. The act of August 26, 1971 (P.L.351, No.91),  
11 known as the State Lottery Law, is amended by adding a section  
12 to read:

13 Section 10.1. Award of Certain Prizes Prohibited.--(a) No  
14 prize shall be awarded unless it shall have been produced or  
15 manufactured within the United States, inclusive of all  
16 territory, continental or insular, subject to the jurisdiction  
17 of the United States. In acquiring prizes for distribution  
18 pursuant to this act, the secretary shall, whenever feasible,  
19 give priority consideration to products manufactured in

1 Pennsylvania.

2 (b) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (a), a  
3 motor vehicle may be awarded as a prize if it can be purchased,  
4 leased or rented by a public agency because the conditions of  
5 section 5(a) of the act of April 4, 1984 (P.L.193, No.40), known  
6 as the "Motor Vehicle Procurement Act," are met.

7 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
