AN ACT

1 Amending the act of December 22, 1983 (P.L.306, No.84), entitled
2 "An act providing for the State Board of Vehicle
3 Manufacturers, Dealers and Salespersons; and providing
4 penalties," FURTHER PROVIDING FOR APPROVAL OF VEHICLE SHOWS <—
5 AND EXHIBITIONS; AND exempting from certain board approval
6 all vehicle shows and exhibitions conducted during and at
7 certain fairs, OR CONDUCTED BY CHARITABLE ORGANIZATIONS. <—

8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

9 hereby enacts as follows:

10 Section 1. Section 23(B)(1) of the act of December 22, 1983 <—
11 (P.L.306, No.84), known as the Board of Vehicles Act, is amended
12 AND THE SECTION IS AMENDED by adding a subsection to read: <—

13 Section 23. Vehicle shows and exhibitions.

14 * * *

15 (B) CONDITIONS FOR APPROVAL.--APPROVAL OF A SHOW OR <—
16 EXHIBITION BY THE BOARD SHALL REQUIRE THE SHOW PROMOTER TO MEET
17 THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS:

18 (1) SUBMIT A REQUEST FOR A SHOW AT LEAST [60] 21 DAYS IN
19 ADVANCE OF THE SHOW DATE WITH: NAME, ADDRESS AND TELEPHONE

1 NUMBER OF THE SHOW PROMOTER, NAME AND LOCATION OF THE SHOW,
2 TYPES OF VEHICLES TO BE DISPLAYED AT THE SHOW, SHOW DATES AND
3 HOURS OF OPERATION.

5 ~~(c) Exemption. Any vehicle show or exhibition held as a~~ <—
6 ~~part of, and in conjunction with, a community or agricultural~~
7 ~~fair which receives funds from the Pennsylvania Fair Fund, shall~~
8 ~~be exempt from the provisions of this section.~~

9 (E) EXEMPTION.--THIS SUBSECTIONS (A), (B) AND (C) OF THIS <—
10 SECTION SHALL NOT APPLY TO A VEHICLE SHOW OR EXHIBITION HELD AS
11 PART OF, AND IN CONJUNCTION WITH, THE FOLLOWING:

12 (1) AN EVENT OPERATED TO BENEFIT A CHARITABLE
13 ORGANIZATION OR GROUP OF CHARITABLE ORGANIZATIONS APPROVED
14 UNDER SECTION 501(C)(3) OF THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE OF 1954
15 (68A STAT. 3, 26 U.S.C. § 501(C)(3)).

16 (2) A COMMUNITY OR AGRICULTURAL FAIR WHICH RECEIVES
17 FUNDS FROM THE PENNSYLVANIA FAIR FUND.

18 Section 2. This act shall take effect ~~in 60 days~~ <—
