## AN ACT

- Amending the act of March 4, 1970 (P.L.128, No.49), entitled "An 2 act granting to the Governor of the Commonwealth the sole authority for regulating the display of the flag of the 3 United States from any public ground or building and from any 4 ground or building of certain other institutions, " further directing the Governor to display the official POW/MIA flag 7 over the Main Capitol Building. 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 10 Section 1. Section 1 of the act of March 4, 1970 (P.L.128, No.49), entitled "An act granting to the Governor of the 11 Commonwealth the sole authority for regulating the display of 12 13 the flag of the United States from any public ground or building and from any ground or building of certain other institutions, " 14 15 is amended by adding a subsection to read: 16 Section 1.
- 17 (c) In addition to any other powers or duties imposed by

- 7 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
