14	Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known	<
15	as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a

18	Department of Education shall provide an Environmental Education

- 7 (3) Preparation of an annual report to the Governor, the
- 8 State Board of Education and the majority and minority chairmen
- 9 <u>of the House Education Committee and the Senate Education</u>
- 10 Committee, outlining environmental education programs and
- 11 <u>achievements</u>, <u>highlighting new initiatives and recommending</u>
- 12 <u>future program needs.</u>
- 13 <u>(4) Providing technical assistance to public and private</u>
- 14 education agencies and local public or private community groups
- 15 <u>or agencies.</u>
- 16 (5) Entering into contracts with or making grants to public
- 17 <u>and private education agencies and local public or private</u>
- 18 community groups or agencies.
- 19 (b) At the discretion of the Secretary of Education, an
- 20 Advisory Council on Environmental Education may be created:
- 21 (1) Membership of the council shall consist of thirteen
- 22 members, seven appointed by the Secretary of Education and six
- 23 appointed by the Secretary of Environmental Resources.
- 24 (2) Members shall be appointed for a five year term. The
- 25 initial term for three members appointed by the Secretary of
- 26 Education and two members appointed by the Secretary of
- 27 Environmental Resources shall be five years; two members
- 28 appointed by the Secretary of Education and two members
- 29 <u>appointed by the Secretary of Environmental Resources shall be</u>
- 30 three years; and two members appointed by the Secretary of

- 1 Education and two members appointed by the Secretary of
- 2 Environmental Resources shall be one year. A member may be
- 3 appointed for more than one term and shall serve until a
- 4 successor has been appointed. Members shall not be compensated,
- 5 but shall be reimbursed for actual expenses in accordance with

- 8 Secretary of Education shall serve as acting chairperson. During
- 9 <u>this meeting</u>, the council membership shall elect a chairperson
- 10 to serve a one year term.
- 11 (4) The Secretary of Education shall designate a staff
- 12 person to serve as an ex officio member and as secretary to the
- 13 <u>council.</u>
- 14 (5) In conjunction with the Secretary of Education, the
- 15 <u>council will adopt bylaws for governing its operations.</u>
- 16 (6) Duties of the advisory council shall include:
- 17 (i) Making recommendations to the Secretary of Education
- 18 with respect to the use of funds appropriated.
- 19 (ii) Reviewing grant proposals and making recommendations to
- 20 the Secretary of Education for approval or disapproval.
- 21 (iii) Advising and assisting the Secretary of Education in
- 22 conducting a continual assessment of the trends and needs in
- 23 environmental education on a local, national and global basis.
- 24 (iv) Developing a program of information dissemination and
- 25 communication with private and public agencies.
