AN ACT

1 Declaring and adopting the song "Pennsylvania Is My Home," by 2 Renie DeMaria, as the State song of the Commonwealth of 3 Pennsylvania. 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 5 hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. Official State song. 6 The song "Pennsylvania Is My Home," by Renie DeMaria, is 7 hereby adopted as the State song of Pennsylvania and shall be the official song for all public purposes. The lyrics of the 10 song are as follows: 11 "PENNSYLVANIA IS MY HOME" Just a few days ago, my mind grew weary, 12 13 And I needed a change of scene. 14 I heard a voice calling me southward 15 To a place that I had never been. Tuscarora casts her shadow 16 On sleepy heads around her feet. 17
