## AN ACT

Making appropriations to the Hahnemann University, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. (a) The sum of $\$ 4,615,000$ is hereby appropriated to the Hahnemann University, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, for the fiscal year July 1, 1987, to June 30, 1988, for instruction in the Doctor of Medicine program.
(b) The sum of $\$ 477,000$ is hereby appropriated to the Hahnemann University, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, for the fiscal year July 1, 1987, to June 30, 1988, for the general maintenance of the Hahnemann University, including the Allied Health, Professions and Graduate School of the Hahnemann University, and student aid.

Section 2. Payments to the Hahnemann University on account of the appropriations provided in section 1 shall be made quarterly by the Secretary of Education on the basis of costs
during the fiscal year.
Section 3. The Hahnemann University shall provide such information as may be necessary to carry out the provisions of this act and in such form and manner as the Department of Education shall prescribe.

Section 4. The Hahnemann University shall report its revenues and expenditures and present its financial statements in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles and procedures for educational institutions as set forth in the "Higher Education Finance Manual (1980)" and the "Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Budget Instructions for the State System of Higher Education, State Related Universities and Non State Related Colleges and Universities."

Section 5. This act shall take effect July 1, 1987, or immediately, whichever is later.
