AN ACT

- 1 Making appropriations to The Medical College of Pennsylvania,
- East Falls, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. The sum of \$2,731,000 is hereby appropriated to
- 6 The Medical College of Pennsylvania located in East Falls,
- 7 Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, for the fiscal year July 1, 1987, to
- 8 June 30, 1988, for instruction in the Doctor of Medicine
- 9 program.
- 10 Section 2. The sum of \$867,000 is hereby appropriated to The
- 11 Medical College of Pennsylvania, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, for
- 12 the fiscal year July 1, 1987, to June 30, 1988, for the general
- 13 maintenance of The Medical College of Pennsylvania, including
- 14 the School of Allied Health, and student aid.
- 15 Section 3. Payments to The Medical College of Pennsylvania
- 16 on account of the appropriations provided in sections 1 and 2
- 17 shall be made quarterly by the Secretary of Education on the

- 1 basis of costs during the fiscal year.
- 2 Section 4. The Medical College of Pennsylvania shall provide
- 3 such information as may be necessary to carry out the provisions
- 4 of this act and in such form and manner as the Department of
- 5 Education shall prescribe.
- 6 Section 5. The Medical College of Pennsylvania shall report
- 7 its revenues and expenditures and present its financial
- 8 statements in accordance with generally accepted accounting
- 9 principles and procedures for educational institutions as set
- 10 forth in the "Higher Education Finance Manual (1980) (1975)" and <---
- 11 the "Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Budget Instructions for the
- 12 State System of Higher Education, State Related Universities and
- 13 Non State Related Colleges and Universities."
- 14 Section 6. This act shall take effect July 1, 1987, or
- 15 immediately, whichever is later.
