16	(b) Eligibility* * *
17	(2) The adjusted loss shall be the total eligible loss
18	including those losses covered by a Small Business
19	Administration loan, a United States Department of

1 Agriculture Farmers Home Administration loan, or any other 2 loan which must be repaid by the applicant minus any amount 3 received by or due the applicant from private insurance and 4 Federal or State grants and shall not include any insurance 5 deductible paid by the applicant.

(g) Appropriation.--The sum of [\$15,000,000] <u>\$19,000,000</u>, or 7 8 as much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated to the Department of Public Welfare for the purposes of this act. 9 10 [Notwithstanding the provisions of any other act to the 11 contrary, the funds hereby appropriated shall not lapse: Provided, however, That any of the] Any funds remaining 12 13 unexpended or uncommitted after [July 1, 1987, shall] payments have been made to individuals, may be used and are hereby 14 15 appropriated for use by the Department of Public Welfare to 16 reimburse municipalities for documented municipal expenditures 17 incurred as a result of a declared disaster in 1984, 1985 or 18 1986 which were not reimbursed by the Federal or State 19 government. If insufficient funds remain to reimburse such 20 municipalities in full, reimbursement shall be made on a pro rata basis. The funds hereby appropriated shall lapse on June 21 22 30, 1988.

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Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

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
