⊥ 2 3	Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, regulating animal research; and providing penalties.
4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby enacts as follows:
6	Section 1. Section 5511(1) of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania
7	Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
8	§ 5511. Cruelty to animals.

10	(1) Search warrantsWhere a violation of this section is
11	alleged, any issuing authority may, in compliance with the
12	applicable provisions of the Pennsylvania Rules of Criminal
13	Procedure, issue to any police officer or any agent of any
14	society or association for the prevention of cruelty to animals
15	duly incorporated under the laws of this Commonwealth a search
16	warrant authorizing the search of any building or any enclosure
17	in which any violation of this section is occurring or has

18 occurred, and authorizing the seizure of evidence of the

violation including, but not limited to, the animals which were 1 2 the subject of the violation. Where an animal thus seized is 3 found to be neglected or starving, the police officer or agent 4 is authorized to provide such care as is reasonably necessary, 5 and where any animal thus seized is found to be disabled, injured or diseased beyond reasonable hope of recovery, the 6 police officer or agent is authorized to provide for the humane 7 8 destruction of the animal. The cost of the keeping, care and destruction of the animal shall be paid by the owner thereof and 9 10 claims for the costs shall constitute a lien upon the animal. In 11 addition to any other penalty provided by law, the authority imposing sentence upon a conviction for any violation of this 12 13 section may require that the owner pay the cost of the keeping, care and destruction of the animal. [No search warrant shall be 14 15 issued based upon an alleged violation of this section which 16 authorizes any police officer or agent or other person to enter 17 upon or search premises where scientific research work is being 18 conducted by, or under the supervision of, graduates of duly 19 accredited scientific schools or where biological products are 20 being produced for the care or prevention of disease.]

22 Section 2. Title 18 is amended by adding a section to read: 23 § 5511.1. Animal research facilities.

24 (a) License required. -- No person, partnership, association 25 or corporation, institution or school shall act as a research 26 facility unless licensed for that purpose by the Secretary of 27 Agriculture, or by the Federal Laboratory Animal Welfare Act 28 (Public Law 89-544, 80 Stat. 350, 7 U.S.C. § 2131). The 29 secretary shall promulgate rules and regulations prescribing standards for issuing a license and prescribe a fee therefor. 30 19870H1554B1835

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1	(b) RegulationsThe secretary shall promulgate regulations
2	to govern humane handling, treatment and care by research
3	facilities and shall employ agents with authority to inspect
4	research facilities at reasonable hours, with or without prior
5	notice of inspection. The secretary shall require certification
б	of formal training for researchers, technicians and attendants
7	who directly handle live animals.
8	(c) Institutional care committeeEach research facility
9	shall form an Institutional Animal Care Committee which shall
10	include representatives of the facility, including not less than
11	one member of the animal care staff, one member who is a State
12	enforcement agent responsible for inspection, and not less than
13	one member who is a representative of an incorporated humane or
14	animal welfare organization. The committee shall ensure that
15	animal care and facilities conform to Federal and State laws and
16	regulations, before, during and after their use.
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1	revoke the license, if such violation is determined to have
2	occurred.
3	(2) Any individual, institution or organization that
4	engages in research or experiments on live animals without a
5	valid license commits a misdemeanor of the third degree.
6	(g) DefinitionsAs used in this section, the following
7	words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
8	subsection:
9	"Animal." Any living vertebrate that is separated from its
10	natural environment and is utilized or intended for use in
11	research, testing and teaching.
12	"Research facility." Any individual, institution,
13	organization, elementary, secondary or postsecondary school that
14	uses or intends to use live animals in research tests or
15	experiments, purchases or transports live animals in commerce or
16	receives State funding, directly or indirectly, for research or
17	facility operations.
18	"Secretary." The Secretary of Agriculture of the
19	Commonwealth.
20	Section 3. Within 60 days of enactment of the provisions of
21	this act, the Governor shall appoint a review committee
22	consisting of representatives of research and humane
23	organizations, to review existing and proposed regulations. The
24	Secretary of Agriculture shall act as chairman of the committee.
25	Regulations shall be developed by the committee designed to
26	minimize the duplication of research, the use of live animals in
27	teaching, testing and research and to ensure humane treatment of
28	animals maintained in research, teaching and other facilities in
29	Pennsylvania.
30	Section 4 This act shall take effect in 60 days

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
