AN ACT

1 Amending the act of May 17, 1921 (P.L.682, No.284), entitled "An
2 act relating to insurance; amending, revising, and
3 consolidating the law providing for the incorporation of
4 insurance companies, and the regulation, supervision, and
5 protection of home and foreign insurance companies, Lloyds
6 associations, reciprocal and inter-insurance exchanges, and
7 fire insurance rating bureaus, and the regulation and
8 supervision of insurance carried by such companies,
9 associations, and exchanges, including insurance carried by
10 the State Workmen's Insurance Fund; providing penalties; and
11 repealing existing laws," requiring coverage of certain
12 workmen's compensation claims in certain fire insurance
13 policies.

14 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
15 hereby enacts as follows:

16 Section 1. Section 506 of the act of May 17, 1921 (P.L.682,
17 No.284), known as The Insurance Company Law of 1921, is amended
18 by adding a subsection to read:

19 Section 506. Fire Insurance Contract; Standard Policy
20 Provisions; Permissible Variations.--

21 * * *

22 9. Except as provided in paragraph (2), no policy providing

1 comprehensive personal liability insurance may be issued or
2 renewed in this Commonwealth on or after January 1, 1988, unless
3 it contains a provision for coverage against liability for the
4 payment of compensation to any employe under the act of June 2,
5 1915 (P.L.736, No.338), known as The Pennsylvania Workmen's
6 Compensation Act.

7 (1) Any such policy in effect on or after January 1, 1988,
8 whether or not actually containing such provisions, shall be
9 construed as if such provisions were embodied therein, except
10 that the coverage shall not apply if any other existing, valid
11 and collectible, workmen's compensation insurance for the
12 liability is applicable to the injury or death of the employe.

13 (2) The requirements of this section shall not apply to any
14 policy of insurance or endorsement where the services of the
15 employe are in connection with the trade, business, profession
16 or occupation of the insured.

17 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
