8	§ 4304. Endangering welfare of children.
9	(a) Offense definedA parent, guardian, or other person
10	supervising the welfare of a child under 18 years of age commits
11	a misdemeanor of the second degree if he knowingly endangers the
12	welfare of the child by violating a duty of care, protection or
13	support.
14	(b) Offense resulting in deathA parent, guardian or other
15	person supervising the welfare of a child under 18 years of age
16	commits a felony of the first degree if he knowingly endangers

- 2 or support and thereby causes the death of the child.
- 3 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
