AN ACT

Amending Title 34 (Game) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further defining "safety zone" to include playground areas; FURTHER PROVIDING FOR RESIDENCY OF MEMBERS 3 4 OF THE ARMED FORCES OF THE UNITED STATES AND OF THE UNITED STATES COAST GUARD AND FOR THE ISSUANCE OF LICENSES TO SUCH PERSONS; FURTHER PROVIDING FOR THE COST AND DURATION OF A DISABLED PERSON'S PERMIT; AND REOUIRING THE GAME COMMISSION TO MAKE CERTAIN REFUNDS. 9 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 10 hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. Section 2505(c) SECTIONS 2505(C), 2702(B) AND 11 (C), 2704(B), 2705(13), 2903 AND 2904(3) of Title 34 of the 12 13 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is ARE amended to read: 14 § 2505. Safety zones. 15 16 (c) Definition. -- As used in this section the term "safety zone" means the area within 150 yards around and that area which 17 is below the highest point of any occupied dwelling house, 18

residence, or other building or camp occupied by human beings,

- 2 therewith or any attached or detached playground of any school,
- 3 nursery school or day-care center.

- 6 (B) COMMONWEALTH RESIDENTS IN ARMED FORCES.--NOTHING IN THIS

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- 7 CHAPTER SHALL DENY ANY QUALIFIED [RESIDENT OF THIS COMMONWEALTH
- 8 SERVING IN THE ARMED FORCES OF THE UNITED STATES AS A RESULT OF
- 9 A FIRST ENLISTMENT OR CONSCRIPTION] SERVICEMAN OR SERVICEWOMAN
- 10 DOMICILED IN BUT RESIDING OUTSIDE THIS COMMONWEALTH WHILE
- 11 <u>SERVING ON ACTIVE DUTY IN THE ARMED FORCES OF THE UNITED STATES</u>
- 12 OR IN THE UNITED STATES COAST GUARD, OR ANY FAMILY MEMBER LIVING
- 13 IN HIS <u>OR HER</u> HOME AND [DOMICILED] <u>RESIDING</u> OUTSIDE THIS
- 14 COMMONWEALTH TO MEET MILITARY REQUIREMENTS, FROM ELIGIBILITY TO
- 15 PROCURE A RESIDENT HUNTER'S LICENSE OR OTHER LICENSE WHEN
- 16 DOMICILE WITHIN THIS COMMONWEALTH IS A REQUIREMENT. PROOF THAT A
- 17 <u>SERVICEMAN'S OR SERVICEWOMAN'S MILITARY HOME OF RECORD IS IN</u>
- 18 PENNSYLVANIA SHALL BE SUFFICIENT TO ESTABLISH DOMICILE IN THIS
- 19 COMMONWEALTH.
- 20 (C) MILITARY PERSONNEL STATIONED IN COMMONWEALTH. -- ANY
- 21 PERSON REGULARLY ENROLLED IN ANY BRANCH OF THE ARMED FORCES OF
- 22 THE UNITED STATES OR IN THE UNITED STATES COAST GUARD AND
- 23 OFFICIALLY STATIONED AND QUARTERED WITHIN THIS COMMONWEALTH [60]
- 24 30 OR MORE DAYS PRECEDING THE DATE OF APPLICATION SHALL BE A
- 25 RESIDENT FOR THE PURPOSE OF THIS TITLE.

- 27 § 2704. ELIGIBILITY FOR LICENSE.

- 29 (B) HUNTER EDUCATION. -- PERSONS WHO HAVE NOT HELD A HUNTING
- 30 LICENSE LAWFULLY ISSUED TO THEM IN THIS COMMONWEALTH OR ANOTHER

- 1 STATE OR NATION OR HAVE NOT HUNTED UNDER THE EXCEPTIONS IN
- 2 SECTION 2706 (RELATING TO RESIDENT LICENSE AND FEE EXEMPTIONS)
- 3 OR DO NOT POSSESS A CERTIFICATE OF TRAINING APPROVED BY THE
- 4 DIRECTOR PRIOR TO THE ENACTMENT OF THIS TITLE SHALL BE REQUIRED
- 5 TO ATTAIN ACCREDITATION IN A HUNTER EDUCATION PROGRAM APPROVED
- 6 BY THE DIRECTOR BEFORE A HUNTING LICENSE IS ISSUED TO THEM. THE
- 7 PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBSECTION SHALL NOT APPLY TO A PERSON WHO
- 8 PRESENTS:
- 9 (1) EVIDENCE OF SERVICE IN THE ARMED FORCES OF THE
- 10 UNITED STATES OR IN THE UNITED STATES COAST GUARD AND
- 11 DISCHARGE OR SEPARATION UNDER HONORABLE CONDITIONS WITHIN SIX
- 12 MONTHS OF THE DATE OF APPLICATION.
- 13 (2) EVIDENCE THAT THE PERSON IS CURRENTLY SERVING IN THE
- 14 ARMED FORCES OF THE UNITED STATES OR IN THE UNITED STATES
- 15 <u>COAST GUARD</u>.

- 17 § 2705. CLASSES OF LICENSES.
- 18 UNLESS OTHERWISE PROVIDED, ANY PERSON WISHING TO EXERCISE ANY
- 19 OF THE PRIVILEGES GRANTED BY THIS TITLE SHALL FIRST SECURE THE
- 20 APPLICABLE RESIDENT OR NONRESIDENT HUNTING OR FURTAKING LICENSE
- 21 AS FOLLOWS:

- 23 (13) ANTLERLESS DEER LICENSES, BEAR LICENSES, ARCHERY
- 24 LICENSES, MUZZLE-LOADER LICENSES AND ANY OTHER LICENSE

- 26 TITLE AND SOUND GAME OR WILDLIFE CONSERVATION TO ELIGIBLE

- 29 <u>LICENSE SHALL BE MADE AVAILABLE TO RESIDENTS SERVING ON</u>

- 2 <u>LIMITATIONS OR APPLICATION DEADLINES.</u> THE NUMBER OF BEAR
- 3 LICENSES WHICH SHALL BE MADE AVAILABLE TO NONRESIDENTS SHALL
- 4 NOT EXCEED 3% OF THE TOTAL NUMBER OF BEAR LICENSES TO BE
- 5 ISSUED BY THE COMMISSION.
- 6 § 2903. PERMIT YEAR.
- 7 EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS TITLE, ALL PERMITS SHALL
- 8 BE ISSUED FOR THE TIME DESIGNATED AS THE FISCAL YEAR FOR THE
- 9 COMMONWEALTH. THE PERMIT FOR A DISABLED PERSON TO HUNT FROM A
- 10 VEHICLE SHALL [COVER THE SAME PERIOD AS THE HUNTING LICENSE] BE
- 11 VALID FOR THE LIFETIME OF THE DISABLED PERSON. THERE WILL BE NO
- 12 REDUCED FEES FOR A PERMIT ISSUED FOR LESS THAN A YEAR.

- 14 THE ANNUAL FEE FOR PERMITS PROVIDED FOR IN THIS CHAPTER SHALL
- 15 BE AS FOLLOWS:

- 17 (3) DISABLED PERSON \$5 [FOR TWO YEARS (EXPIRES EVERY
- 18 EVEN YEAR)] FOR THE LIFETIME OF THE DISABLED PERSON.
- 19 * * *
- 20 SECTION 2. THE GAME COMMISSION SHALL REFUND TO ELIGIBLE
- 21 MEMBERS OF THE ARMED FORCES OR THE UNITED STATES COAST GUARD ALL
- 22 FINES AND PENALTIES COLLECTED BY COURT ACTION OR ACKNOWLEDGMENT
- 23 OF GUILT FOR VIOLATIONS OF SECTION 2702(B) AND (C) AND ALSO THE
- 24 DIFFERENCE BETWEEN THE COSTS OF A RESIDENT LICENSE AND A
- 25 NONRESIDENT LICENSE FOR THOSE QUALIFIED MEMBERS OF THE ARMED
- 26 FORCES OR THE UNITED STATES COAST GUARD WHO PURCHASED A
- 27 NONRESIDENT LICENSE. THESE REFUNDS SHALL BE PAID NO LATER THAN
- 28 JUNE 30, 1990.
- 29 SECTION 3. THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 2702(B) AND (C) SHALL
- 30 BE RETROACTIVE TO JULY 1, 1987.
