- Amending the act of July 10, 1968 (P.L.316, No.154), entitled "An act establishing a code of ethics for the General Assembly, its officers and employes, and providing remedies for its enforcement and penalties, " restricting attorney 4 members of the General Assembly from representing clients before State agencies, State appellate courts, courts of 6 common pleas and the minor judiciary. 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

- Section 1. The act of July 10, 1968 (P.L.316, No.154), known 10

- 13 Section 5.1. Representation before Certain Agencies
- Prohibited. -- No attorney member of the General Assembly shall 14
- 15 represent any client before any State agency, State appellate
- court, court of common pleas or any court of the minor 16
- 17 judiciary.
- 18 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
