- 14 (b) Justices, judges and justices of the peace shall be
- 15 retired [upon attaining] on the last day of the calendar year in
- 16 which they attain the age of 70 years. Former and retired
- 17 justices, judges and justices of the peace shall receive such

- 1 compensation as shall be provided by law. No compensation shall
- 2 be paid to any justice, judge or justice of the peace who is
- 3 suspended or removed from office under section 18 of this
- 4 article or under Article VI.

- 6 Section 2. This proposed amendment shall be submitted by the
- 7 Secretary of the Commonwealth to the qualified electors of this
- 8 Commonwealth at the general election next held after the
- 9 advertising requirements of section 1 of Article XI of the
- 10 Constitution of Pennsylvania have been satisfied.
