## AN ACT

Amending the act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1333, No.320), entitled 1 "An act concerning elections, including general, municipal, 2 3 special and primary elections, the nomination of candidates, 4 primary and election expenses and election contests; creating 5 and defining membership of county boards of elections; imposing duties upon the Secretary of the Commonwealth, 6 7 courts, county boards of elections, county commissioners; 8 imposing penalties for violation of the act, and codifying, revising and consolidating the laws relating thereto; and 9 repealing certain acts and parts of acts relating to 10 elections," further providing for form of official primary 11 12 ballot.

13 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

14 hereby enacts as follows:

15 Section 1. Section 1002(b) of the act of June 3, 1937

16 (P.L.1333, No.320), known as the Pennsylvania Election Code,

17 amended December 2, 1976 (P.L.1221, No.269), is amended to read:

18 Section 1002. Form of Official Primary Ballot.--\* \* \*

(b) On the back of each ballot shall be printed in prominent type the words "OFFICIAL PRIMARY BALLOT OF .....PARTY FOR" followed by the designation of the election district for which it is prepared, the date of the primary and the facsimile

signatures of the members of the county board of elections. The 1 names of candidates shall in all cases be arranged under the 2 3 title of the office for which they are candidates, and be 4 printed thereunder in the order determined by the casting of 5 lots as provided by this act. Under the title of such offices where more than one candidate is to be voted for, shall be 6 printed "Vote for not more than ....." (the blank space to 7 indicate the number of candidates to be voted for the particular 8 office.) At the right of the name of each candidate there shall 9 10 be a square of sufficient size for the convenient insertion of a 11 cross (x) or check () mark. There shall be left at the end of the list of candidates for each office (or under the title of 12 13 the office itself in case there be no candidates who have filed 14 nomination petitions therefor) as many blank spaces as there are 15 persons to be voted for, for such office, in which space the 16 elector may insert the name of any person whose name is not printed on the ballot as a candidate for such office. Opposite 17 18 or under the name of each candidate, except candidates for the 19 office of President of the United States and candidates for 20 delegate or alternate delegate to a National Party Convention, 21 who is to be voted for by the electors of more than one county, 22 shall be printed the name of the county in which such candidate resides; and opposite or under the name of each candidate except 23 24 candidates for delegate or alternate delegate to a National 25 Party Convention who is to be voted for by the electors of an entire county or any congressional, senatorial or representative 26 district within the county, or for member of a State committee 27 28 shall be printed the name of the city, borough, township or 29 ward, as the case may be, in which such candidate resides. \* \* \* 30

1 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
