AN ACT

Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, providing for a Vietnam veteran registration plate.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
hereby enacts as follows:
Section 1. Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
§ 1348. Vietnam veteran plates.
On the application of any person who was a Vietnam veteran,
as determined by the Veterans' Administration, the department shall issue a special registration plate designating the vehicle as belonging to a Vietnam veteran. The registration plate shall have a white background, shall have red numbers or letters as the department may determine, shall have the outline of the entire country of Vietnam in red, and shall have the words "Vietnam Veteran," in at least 10-point boldface type, inscribed pounds.

6 plate shall be issued to a Vietnam veteran under this section. It may be used only on one passenger vehicle or one other vehicle with a registered gross weight of not more than 9,000

Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
