AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated 2 Statutes, providing for a Vietnam veteran registration plate.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 6 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 7 § 1348. Vietnam veteran plates.
- 8 On the application of any person who was a Vietnam veteran,
- 9 as determined by the Veterans' Administration, the department
- 10 shall issue a special registration plate designating the vehicle
- 11 as belonging to a Vietnam veteran. The registration plate shall
- 12 have a white background, shall have red numbers or letters as
- 13 the department may determine, shall have the outline of the
- 14 entire country of Vietnam in red, and shall have the words
- 15 "Vietnam Veteran," in at least 10-point boldface type, inscribed

- in red at the bottom of the plate. Only one special registration 1
- 2 plate shall be issued to a Vietnam veteran under this section.
- 3 <u>It may be used only on one passenger vehicle or one other</u>
- 4 <u>vehicle with a registered gross weight of not more than 9,000</u>
- 5 pounds.
- Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days. 6
