AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 2 Statutes, providing for the appointment of special officers
- 3 to assist local police in enforcing certain parking
- 4 regulations.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 8 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 9 § 6109.1. Handicapped parking enforcement.
- 10 (a) Appointment of special enforcement officers.--Local
- 11 authorities may appoint special volunteer handicapped parking
- 12 enforcement officers to assist local police in enforcing the
- 13 provisions of section 3354(d) (relating to additional parking
- 14 regulations). The powers and duties of the special volunteer
- 15 handicapped parking enforcement officers shall be limited to
- 16 <u>enforcing the provisions of section 3354(d).</u>
- 17 (b) Method of appointment. -- Special volunteer handicapped
- 18 parking enforcement officers shall be appointed by the police

- 1 chief of the municipality and subject to the approval of the
- 2 <u>chief of police of each municipality in which the enforcement</u>
- 3 <u>officer serves. Appointments shall be for a term of two years.</u>
- 4 (c) Badge and equipment. -- The Department of Community
- 5 Affairs shall provide each special volunteer handicapped parking
- 6 enforcement officer with a badge or other sign of authority and
- 7 any other equipment or supplies that special volunteer
- 8 <u>handicapped parking enforcement officers may reasonably require.</u>
- 9 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
