AN ACT

1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated  
2 Statutes, providing for the appointment of special officers  
3 to assist local police in enforcing certain parking  
4 regulations.

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated  
8 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:

9 § 6109.1. Handicapped parking enforcement.

10 (a) Appointment of special enforcement officers.--Local  
11 authorities may appoint special volunteer handicapped parking  
12 enforcement officers to assist local police in enforcing the  
13 provisions of section 3354(d) (relating to additional parking  
14 regulations). The powers and duties of the special volunteer  
15 handicapped parking enforcement officers shall be limited to  
16 enforcing the provisions of section 3354(d).

17 (b) Method of appointment.--Special volunteer handicapped  
18 parking enforcement officers shall be appointed by the police

1 chief of the municipality and subject to the approval of the  
2 chief of police of each municipality in which the enforcement  
3 officer serves. Appointments shall be for a term of two years.

4 (c) Badge and equipment.--The Department of Community  
5 Affairs shall provide each special volunteer handicapped parking  
6 enforcement officer with a badge or other sign of authority and  
7 any other equipment or supplies that special volunteer  
8 handicapped parking enforcement officers may reasonably require.

9 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
